59 public-use airports in Arizona



214 bridges (**2.6%**) are structurally deficient and Arizona spent **\$49,318,852** on bridge capital projects in 2013



There are **108** high-hazard potential dams and **93%** of Arizona's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



\$6.1 billion in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



123.2 trillion British thermal units of renewable energy produced, ranking **#31** nationally



9 sites on the National Priorities List



901 miles of levees in Arizona in the National Levee Database



\$162.7 million of unmet needs for its parks system



1,643 miles of rail across the state, ranking **#36** by mileage nationally



66,122 miles of public roads, with **15%** in poor condition



\$481 per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair
