65 public-use airports in Indiana



\$510 million of unmet needs for its parks system

1,533 bridges (8.0%) are structurally deficient and Indiana spent \$244,436,307 on bridge capital projects in 2013



73.2 million short tons of cargo in 2014, ranking it #12 nationally

There are 240 high-hazard potential dams and 35% of Indiana's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



4,075 miles of rail across the state, ranking #9 by mileage nationally

\$5.9 billion in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



96,571 miles of public roads, with 8% in poor condition

215.4 trillion British thermal units of renewable energy produced, ranking #14 nationally



\$272 per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

39 sites on the National Priorities List



\$518 million gap in estimated school capital expenditures in Indiana
