63 public-use airports in Pennsylvania



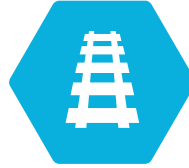
\$24.3 million of unmet needs for its parks system

4,506 bridges (**19.8%**) are structurally deficient and Pennsylvania spent **\$974,843,009** on bridge capital projects in 2013



65 million short tons of cargo in 2014, ranking it **#13** nationally

There are **756** high-hazard potential dams and **94%** of Pennsylvania's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



5,151 miles of rail across the state, ranking **#5** by mileage nationally

\$14.2 billion in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



120,091 miles of public roads, with **32%** in poor condition

184.9 trillion British thermal units of renewable energy produced, ranking **#18** nationally



\$606 per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair
