

## Key Facts About South Dakota's Infrastructure

**58** public-use airports in South Dakota



**\$26.25 million** of unmet needs for its parks system

**1,147** bridges (**19.6%**) are structurally deficient and South Dakota spent **\$17,848,229** on bridge capital projects in 2013



**1,753 miles** of rail across the state, ranking **#35** by mileage nationally

There are **46** high-hazard potential dams and **96%** of South Dakota's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



**82,576 miles** of public roads, with **17%** in poor condition

**\$738.1 million** in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



**\$528** per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

**223.5 trillion British thermal units** of renewable energy produced, ranking **#13** nationally



**\$125 million gap** in estimated school capital expenditures in South Dakota

**2** sites on the National Priorities List



**2,888,813** annual unlinked passenger trips via transit systems including bus, transit, and commuter trains
