1,147 bridges (19.6%) are structurally deficient and South Dakota spent \$17,848,229 on bridge capital projects in 2013





There are 46 high-hazard potential dams and 96% of South Dakota's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



82,576 miles of public roads, with **17%** in poor condition

\$738.1 million in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years
