78 public-use airports in Arkansas



\$231.72 million of unmet needs for its parks system

811 bridges (6.3%) are structurally deficient and Arkansas spent \$96,180,878 on bridge capital projects in 2013



18.2 million short tons of cargo in 2014, ranking it #30 nationally

There are 114 high-hazard potential dams and 89% of Arkansas's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



2,698 miles of rail across the state, ranking #25 by mileage nationally

\$7.4 billion in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



102,609 miles of public roads, with 24% in poor condition

109.8 trillion British thermal units of renewable energy produced, ranking #32 nationally



\$589 per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

9 sites on the National Priorities List



\$587 million gap in estimated school capital expenditures in Arkansas

1,860 miles of inland waterways, ranking #3 nationally
