

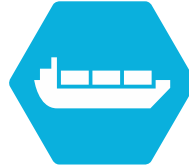
## Key Facts About Delaware's Infrastructure

4 public-use airports in Delaware



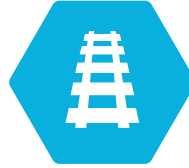
**\$12.25 million** of unmet needs for its parks system

43 bridges (4.9%) are structurally deficient and Delaware spent **\$37,647,770** on bridge capital projects in 2013



**14.4 million short tons** of cargo in 2014, ranking it **#31** nationally

There are 43 high-hazard potential dams and 91% of Delaware's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



**250 miles** of rail across the state, ranking **#48** by mileage nationally

**\$368.8 million** in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



**6,416 miles** of public roads, with **16%** in poor condition

4.2 trillion British thermal units of renewable energy produced, ranking **#50** nationally



**\$394** per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

13 sites on the National Priorities List



**\$102 million gap** in estimated school capital expenditures in Delaware

100 miles of inland waterways, ranking **#31** nationally



**10,257,127** annual unlinked passenger trips via transit systems including bus, transit, and commuter trains

13 miles of levees in Delaware in the National Levee Database
