

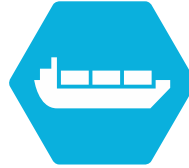
Key Facts About Florida's Infrastructure

100 public-use airports in Florida



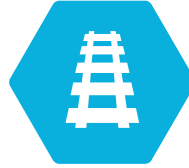
\$32.13 million of unmet needs for its parks system

256 bridges (2.1%) are structurally deficient and Florida spent \$318,844,305 on bridge capital projects in 2013



98.7 million short tons of cargo in 2014, ranking it #8 nationally

There are 79 high-hazard potential dams and 41% of Florida's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



2,900 miles of rail across the state, ranking #24 by mileage nationally

\$16.5 billion in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



122,659 miles of public roads, with 11% in poor condition

248.6 trillion British thermal units of renewable energy produced, ranking #12 nationally



\$327 per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

53 sites on the National Priorities List



279,270,548 annual unlinked passenger trips via transit systems including bus, transit, and commuter trains

1,540 miles of inland waterways, ranking #5 nationally
