56 public-use airports in Louisiana



\$215.07 million of unmet needs for its parks system

1,739 bridges (13.5%) are structurally deficient and Louisiana spent \$203,727,913 on bridge capital projects in 2013



544 million short tons of cargo in 2014, ranking it #1 nationally

There are 43 high-hazard potential dams and 100% of Louisiana's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



2,927 miles of rail across the state, ranking #23 by mileage nationally

\$5.3 billion in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



61,419 miles of public roads, with 26% in poor condition

142.9 trillion British thermal units of renewable energy produced, ranking #25 nationally



\$583 per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair
