

## Key Facts About South Carolina's Infrastructure

**53** public-use airports in South Carolina



**\$220 million** of unmet needs for its parks system

**964** bridges (**10.3%**) are structurally deficient and South Carolina spent **\$61,358,100** on bridge capital projects in 2013



**20.3 million short tons** of cargo in 2014, ranking it **#28** nationally

There are **178** high-hazard potential dams and **89%** of South Carolina's regulated dams have an Emergency Action Plan



**2,311 miles** of rail across the state, ranking **#31** by mileage nationally

**\$1.8 billion** in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



**76,250 miles** of public roads, with **16%** in poor condition

**126.9 trillion British thermal units** of renewable energy produced, ranking **#30** nationally



**\$502** per motorist per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

**25** sites on the National Priorities List



**\$90 million gap** in estimated school capital expenditures in South Carolina

**480 miles** of inland waterways, ranking **#19** nationally



**12,681,902** annual unlinked passenger trips via transit systems including bus, transit, and commuter trains

**18 miles** of levees in South Carolina in the National Levee Database
