



Key Facts About Florida's Infrastructure

100 public-use airports in Florida



\$32.13 million of unmet needs for its parks system

12,355 bridges, **2.1%** of which were structurally deficient in 2017





98.7 million short tons of cargo in 2014, ranking it #8 nationally

There are 1,110 dams in Florida, 102 of which are high-hazard potential. Of the high-hazard potential dams, 24% have an Emergency Action Plan





2,851 miles of rail across the state, ranking #23 by mileage nationally

\$806 million in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years





122,848 miles of public roads, with 9% in poor condition. Each motorist pays \$352 per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

53 sites on the Superfund National Priorities List





240,202,525 annual unlinked passenger trips via transit systems including bus, transit, and commuter trains in 2017

1,540 of inland waterways, ranking #5 nationally





\$18.4 billion in wastewater infrastructure needs over 20 years
