



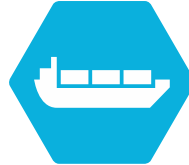
Key Facts About Indiana's Infrastructure

65 public-use airports in Indiana



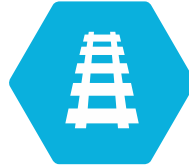
\$510 million of unmet needs for its parks system

19,291 bridges, 7.4% of which were structurally deficient in 2017



73.2 million short tons of cargo in 2014, ranking it #12 nationally

There are 912 dams in Indiana, 266 of which are high-hazard potential. Of the high-hazard potential dams, 50% have an Emergency Action Plan



3,786 miles of rail across the state, ranking #11 by mileage nationally

\$7.52 billion in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



96,790 miles of public roads, with 13% in poor condition. Each motorist pays \$480 per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

40 sites on the Superfund National Priorities List



\$518 million gap in estimated school capital expenditures in Indiana

350 of inland waterways, ranking #23 nationally



32,502,359 annual unlinked passenger trips via transit systems including bus, transit, and commuter trains in 2017

395 miles of levees in Indiana in the National Levee Database



7.16 billion in wastewater infrastructure needs over 20 years
