



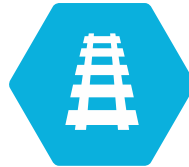
Key Facts About South Dakota's Infrastructure

58 public-use airports in South Dakota



\$26.25 million of unmet needs for its parks system

5,818 bridges, 18.6% of which were structurally deficient in 2017



2,029 miles of rail across the state, ranking #33 by mileage nationally

There are 2,562 dams in South Dakota, 90 of which are high-hazard potential. Of the high-hazard potential dams, 96% have an Emergency Action Plan



82,584 miles of public roads, with 14% in poor condition. Each motorist pays \$564 per year in costs from driving on roads in need of repair

\$6.12 billion in drinking water infrastructure needs over 20 years



\$125 million gap in estimated school capital expenditures in South Dakota

2 sites on the Superfund National Priorities List



2,921,938 annual unlinked passenger trips via transit systems including bus, transit, and commuter trains in 2017

80 of inland waterways, ranking #33 nationally



\$166 million in wastewater infrastructure needs over 20 years

181 miles of levees in South Dakota in the National Levee Database
